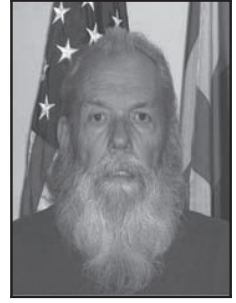

All General Regulations and Division 100 Rules apply. In regard to responsibility for items entered, see General Regulations.

SPECIAL RULES

1. This department is for FRESH CUT and DRIED Flowers and must have been grown by the exhibitor. *Except for the arrangement classes - 22 to 29 and 26 to 33.*
2. ONLY ONE (1) entry per Lot; 6 entries overall.
3. All specimen flowers should be exhibited with natural foliage attached. NO ADDED FOLIAGE.
4. All entries must be prepared in accordance with good show procedures and must have the number of specimens requested in each lot.
5. Containers will be furnished for exhibitors in fresh cut specimens in fresh cut specimens classes and class 15 dried floral.

6. The exhibitor must know what kind of specimen they are bringing in to exhibit.
7. Judging age groups are: Adult = age 18+; Junior = age 12 to 17; Children = age 5 - 11. *Be sure to note age on pre-registration entry form.* Challenged may enter as Junior, do not give age on entry form.
